
To ensure that we can achieve our vision and mission by the year 2020, strategic planning and activities are formulated as per below:



HOW TO APPLY

Application Procedures

All international students are required to read the guidelines to ensure all information is complete. There are essentially three (3) basic steps to the application process at North Borneo University College:

STEP A SUBMISSION OF DOCUMENTS

STEP B OFFER LETTER

STEP C VISA APPROVAL LETTER

STEP A: Submission of Documents

Students are advised to read the requirements for admission carefully and ensure all information submitted is complete and true.

- 1. Obtain an Application Form from NBUC International Office, NBUC Representatives or download from the FORM section under Online Resources section in our website.
- 2. Submission can be done via Online Registration, send in the printed form and relevant documents to NBUC International Office directly or through an authorised representative in your country.
- 3. Complete the form and attach the following documents:

International students applying from Country of Origin (New applicants)

- a. To apply, please make application fee payment
- b. Passport sized photographs (4cm X 5.5cm, white background) with applicant's name and passport number written on the back side;
- c. Certified true copies of all academic qualifications and English Proficiency Test (IELTS, TOEFL or equivalent);
- d. A complete set your passport photocopy all pages including blank pages. (The passport must have a validity period of at least 12 months);
- e. An updated resume (for Postgraduate programme applications only);
- f. Employment confirmation letter from employer (if applicable)

International students applying within Malaysia (Transfer student)

- To register, please make payment for application fee; together with all documents from (b) to (f) listed above;
- Offer Letter will be issued by North Borneo University College;
- Request for the following documents from recent college/ institution and ensure that all documents are CERTIFIED TRUE COPIES by the college/ institution;
 - a. Release letter;
 - b. Attendance record;
 - c. Result slip or academic transcripts or certificates.

STEP B: Offer Letter

- ▶ Upon receiving the application form, payment of application fees and relevant supporting documents, as explained above, NBUC will email a copy of the Offer Letter to the student if the International Student is accepted.
- Students need to pay first tuition fee installment as stated in the Offer Letter (either by Telegraphic Transfer to NBUC Bank Account or Bank Draft).
- NBUC International Office will submit the documents to the Sabah Immigration Department to begin the process of Visa Approval Application.

STEP C: Visa Approval Letter

Once International Office has received the VISA APPROVAL LETTER, it will be sent or posted together with the original Offer Letter to the eligible applicant. Once received, applicant may proceed to applying a STUDENT PASS from the nearest Malaysian Embassy in the respective home or source country.





are obliged to satisfy the minimum entry requirements and additional entry conditions for the particular program you are applying.

NBUC International office will assist student to validate on minimum entry requirements. Successful selection for admission to any program shall be at the sole discretion of the university.

PROGRAMMES	MINIMUM ENTRY REQUIREMENTS
FOUNDATION	GCE O-Level with minimum 5 subjects pass with Credit including a Mathematics subject; or Any other equivalent qualifications recognized by Malaysia government.
DIPLOMA	GCE O-Level with minimum 3 subjects pass with Credit including at least pass grade in Mathematics; or Any equivalent qualifications recognized by Malaysia government.
BACHELOR DEGREE	GCE A-Level with minimum 2 principal passes or CGPA 2.0; or Pass Foundation, Matriculation or Diploma in relevant field recognized by the Senate with minimum CGPA 2.0; or Any other equivalent qualification accepted by the University Senate.
MASTER DEGREE	Bachelor degree (MQF Level 6) with minimum, CGPA 2.50, or other equivalent qualification accepted by the University Senate; or Bachelor degree (MQF level 6) with less than CGPA 2.50, plus 5 years working experience in related field; or Any other equivalent qualifications recognized by Malaysia government.
DOCTORAL DEGREE	A Master degree (MQF Level 7) in related field as accepted by the University Senate; or Any qualifications equivalent to Master's Degree (MQF Level 7) or as accepted by the University Senate.

English Proficiency Test

All international students applying for degree and postgraduate programmes, are required to meet the minimum English results:

Bachelor / Master Degree	IELTS 5.0	TOEFL 500	or equivalent
Doctoral Degree	IELTS 6.0	TOEFL 550	or equivalent

^{*} Aside from TOEFL and IELTS, a minimum of Band 3 achievement in Malaysian University English Test (MUET) will be accepted but is only applicable to international students who are applying for an undergraduate programme.

A sanctuary away from the city, prep yourself before a kundasang trip with our comprehensive guide on what to know and where to go for your next visit to the Land below the wind.




The centre attracts tourist and researches alike, giving them the opportunity to watch the Orang Utan up close in their natural habitat. A broadwalk which leads to a viewing gallery and feeding platform where the Apes are fed milk and banana twice a day at 10am and 3pm by rangers. Feeding time also attracts long-tailed macaques to the area.



In the heart of the city, Gaya Street has been the centre of business for over hundred years. Built in the 1950's and 1960's, the shophouses were used in traditional way, with shops on the ground floor and residential units on the upper floor.







The marine park is a cluster of Five islands - Pulau Gaya, Pulau Sapi, Pulau Sapi, Pulau manukan, Pulau Mamutik and Pulau Sulug about 20 minutes by speedboat from the city. Take a dip in the waters for a snorkel, a dive or some sea walking. Or stay on the shore and bask in the sun with a picnic basket.



Sabah's coral reefs are home to some of the largest, most varied communities of marine life on earth. Apart from their biological significance, these reefs fringe a number of exotic islands which have become important centres from marine research and conservation.

These include the islands of Tunku Abdul Rahman Park, Pulau Tiga, the Turtle Island, the Tun Sakaran Marine Park and Pulau Sipadan Park, under the juridiction of Sabah Parks.



Located 10 minutes from the city center, this place is closest to the heart of locals. Taking its name from the casuarinas or aru trees that fringe its sandy shores, this is where the best sunsets are seen,
